Complete the Miller Electric Service Training program to equip you with the knowledge and skills to succeed. The program is a dynamic blend of self-paced and structured learning, totaling approximately 36.5 hours, and includes:



Foundational Service Repair: Learn basic safety and electrical principles to begin welder evaluation and repair. These online courses are a prerequisite for all service training theory and diagnostic content. This flexible, self-paced training takes about 3 hours to complete.



Service Repair: Learn the skills to accurately diagnose, estimate, and repair welding equipment. Learn key theory and troubleshooting concepts for SCR, engine drive and inverter technologies. Classes are offered virtually or onsite Miller Electric's Appleton campus. This structured, hands-on training with instructor support takes about 32 hours to complete.



Service Technician Certification: Complete the online CST exam with a score of 86% or higher to become certified. This on-demand assessment is designed to be completed in approximately 1.5 hours.
